Profile of Aioi City

Population: 30,000 Area: 90km²

By JR Line / Shinkansen from Himeji 20min/10 min., to Osaka 80min/50min. Only 2km to the seaside from the station.



Aioi Station & Front area

Inside the station, a Shinkansen train passes at 300 km/h in front

of you. A peron boat is exhibited in the Shinkansen concourse.

You can go by a taxi, bus, bicycle or foot to the seaside / downtown. Three hotels are available near the station. There is a variety of restaurants to choose from.

Shops, supermarkets, and restaurants are available in this area. Credit cards are accepted only in the supermarkets.


Restaurant options include

You can enjoy seafood BBQ or fresh fish. Among them Kaisendon (a bowl of rice topped with sashimi) is well reputed. During the winter season fresh oysters grown in Aioi Bay are served.
